and are approved according to the

German Recomendation XXXVI for the helth-related evaluation of materials and objects for the contact with foodstuffs in the frame of the Foodstuffs and Animal Feed Code, 34'th memorandum, Bundesgesundheitsblatt 10, 14 (1967) including the 214'th memorandum

Bundesgesundheitsblatt 55, 291-294 (2012), state of 1 January 2012

and according to the demands

Code of Federal Regulations, Food and Drugs (FDA), 21 CFR Ch. I (1Apr2013 Edition), §176.170 for the used raw materials, fabrication additives and special paper finishing agents as well as for the release of substances which might endanger health.

Raw materials were examinated according to the Methods of testing papers and boards for food packaging state of 2008, corresponding to the method no 80.56 within the Official Collection of Test Methods according to §64 of teh Foodstuffs and Animal Feed Code(LFGB)

analysed for theis heavy metal contents according to the

Directive 94/62/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 20 December 1994, on packaging and packaging waste, Official Journal of the European Communities L365/10 of 31 December 1994, last amandment by the Directive 2013/2/EU of the Commision of 7 February 2013, official Journal of the EU L 37/10 of 8 February 2013

and can be safely use for food packaging. They may stand in direct contact with dry, moisty and fatty foodstuffs.

We hereby warrant that substances or products causing allergies or intolerances listed in Regulation (EU) No 1169/2011 Annex II and in the Food Allergen Labelling and Consumer Protection Act of 2004 (FALCPA, U.S.A.) are not used as raw materials in the manufacturing process of this product.
